What is a Technical Room?

A technical room is an area of any size that contains technical or computer equipment. Because this equipment has special maintenance requirements, office cleaners should never be allowed to clean technical rooms.

Why Clean a Technical Room?

The main aim is to minimise the risk of critical equipment failure due to static discharge or dust contamination. Many companies and organisations see the benefit of planned regular maintenance in other ways. High profile image-conscious organisations want to ensure that they benefit from improved preventative measures. They also want to show how they care for their own technical environments as a way of conveying their diligence and professionalism to clients and prospective clients. In addition, companies and organisations see that improved working conditions lead to improved staff morale and productivity.
